You need nothing special to make a Kawandi, other than fabric, thread, and a needle. The following are my favorite supplies.

- 12" square of batting
- Backing - 14" square
- Small pile of scraps - soft and easy to stitch through
- Sue Spargo's #3 Milliners needle
- Wonderfil 12-weight thread
- Thimble - I use one that goes over my first knuckle, so I push with the side of my finger
- Needle grabber
- Sharp scissors



# EPP Made Easy with Freezer Paper

## Specific supplies

- Freezer Paper Sheets or a roll of freezer paper cut into sheets that fit in your printer
- The PDF of 1" hexagons I created for you - [Click to get the Hexagon Templates](#)
- Ruler with ¼" markings (I use the Add-A-Quarter Ruler, 6" is preferred)
- Rotary cutter 45MM (the normal size)
- Cutting mat
- Iron and ironing surface
- Sharp paper scissors

## Fabric

- Scrap fabric on which a 1" hexagon will fit, with at least a 1/4" around the hexagon
- Fabric with a motif that will fit inside a 1" hexagon
- We will be stitching Grandmother's hexagon flowers

## Sewing supplies

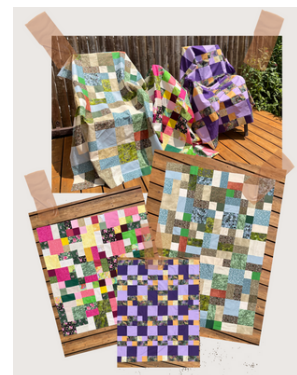
- Needle and thread if you plan to hand-stitch
- Sewing machine if you plan to stitch by machine. A quarter-inch foot is the best choice to sew with

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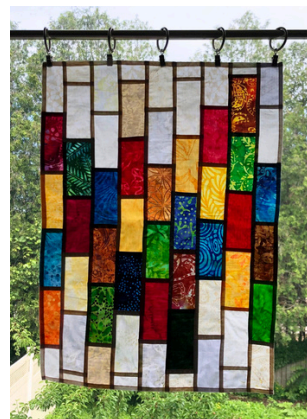

## **Fabric and Supplies:**

- 3 strips 2.5 inch wide
- 2 x 6.5-inch squares (or strip of fabric 6 x 10 inch)
- 5x8 inch of fusible interfacing (lightweight)
- 50 inches of rope of your choice
- Matching thread
- Button
- Zipper foot (optional)
- Ruler
- Iron
- Hand sewing needle

Scraps of two different orange fabrics for the pumpkin (each approx. 4" x 6")

Smaller scraps of contrasting fabrics for the background (all the same color)

Neutral thread

Sewing machine

6" x 12" rotary cutter ruler

Rotary cutter and mat

Pins

Scissors (for both paper and fabric)

Iron and ironing board or pad

Optional: "Add-a-Quarter" ruler

# Foldable Fabric Basket

Kris O'Neill | Sew the Distance

## Fabric:

- (16) Assorted 2.5" x 6.5" of fabric
- (12) Assorted 2.5" x 6.5" of fabric strips
- (16) Assorted 2.5" x 5" fabric strips
- (4) Assorted 2.5" x 16.5" fabric strips

**Choosing Fabrics Strips:** These can be all different or duplicated prints. Leftover binding strips and leftover jelly roll strips work beautifully for this project. These fabrics can match, coordinate, or just be "anything goes" scrappy. If you are new to quilting or just want a super low-stress project, pick busier prints as it will help camouflage any imperfections.

## Batting:

15" Square of Light Weight Batting: Fusible fleece works well for this, but any light-weight batting can be used. Fabric Scraps pieced together will work perfectly for this project, too.

## Thread:

- Matching Thread for Piecing and Assembly
- For Optional Machine Quilting: Coordinating Thread for Quilting

## Tools:

- Sewing machine in good working order, cleaned, and with a fresh needle
- Sewing machine feet: Piecing foot, Walking Foot, Machine Quilting Feet, if machine quilting the project (optional)
- Iron, ironing surface, cutting mat, quilting ruler(s), rotary cutter with a sharp blade, spray adhesive (if using non-fusible batting), small scissors or snips, school glue, clips, pins, large safety pin (between 2"-2.5" works best), point turner, chopstick, crochet hook, or knitting needle all work well, too.)

## Optional by Helpful:

- 15" Square Ruler
- Tailor's Clapper for Pressing Seams
